In recent years Margate has enjoyed a startling regeneration from “the wasteland” to becoming one of the hippest destinations on the South East coast, coined ‘Shoreditch-on-Sea’. A place where artists, creatives and DFLs have flocked since the construction of The Turner Contemporary. Insider knowledge beyond the ‘official’ channels, from our own research and first hand anecdotes from long-term residents, people who have spent their lives in Margate and witnessed all these changes first hand.
